“Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a proactive approach to establishing the behavioral supports and social culture and needed for all students in a school to achieve social, emotional and academic success.”

## Why are we using PBIS?

- ▶ To create a **positive school wide culture**
- ▶ To **prevent behaviors** before they occur
- ▶ To have a **shared positive language** between staff, students, and parents
- ▶ To increase **positive interactions**
- ▶ To **promote** positive behavior



## Pride, Safety, Self

**Pride** – Have pride in our school, our things and our learning

**Safety** – Keep yourself and your peers safe

**Self** – Take care of yourself, help yourself to learn and do your best each day

<b>S</b> it correctly			<b>Outside Voice</b> (Recess)
<b>T</b> rack the speaker			<b>Inside Voice</b> (Group work, lunch)
<b>A</b> nsWER/Ask questions			<b>Spy Talk</b> (Whisper)
<b>R</b> espect ALL!			<b>Silent</b> (Hallway, test, individual work)
