Playground Rules

We have playground rules so that all students can play, explore and be creative in a safe environment. Following the rules shows respect for others and helps prevent injuries.

- 1. Stay within the playground boundaries (You should not be out of sight)
 - Inside the tree line
 - In front of sheds
 - In front of benches and off rocks
 - Away from dumpsters and shed grass area (Students may go to this area to retrieve a ball but it is not a playing area. The picnic table can be used to take-a-break or complete work.)
- 2. Use equipment for its intended purpose
- Climb across the monkey bars, do not sit on top
- Backstop (fence near baseball diamond) is for stopping balls not climbing
- If using red spinners you must start at the first one. One student at a time in one direction.
- Students can use any equipment that they can reach unassisted
- 3. Take turns and share equipment
- 4. Play by the rules
- 5. Line up when the signal is given
- 6. Use polite language
- 7. Invite others to play
- 8. Dress appropriately for the weather.
 - Flip flops are not allowed on playground equipment.
 - In order to be in the snow students must have boots AND SNOW PANTS.
